This document will guide you through the installation and usage of the module.

II INSTALLATION GUIDE

The installation process is the same in version 1.5.X of Prestashop.

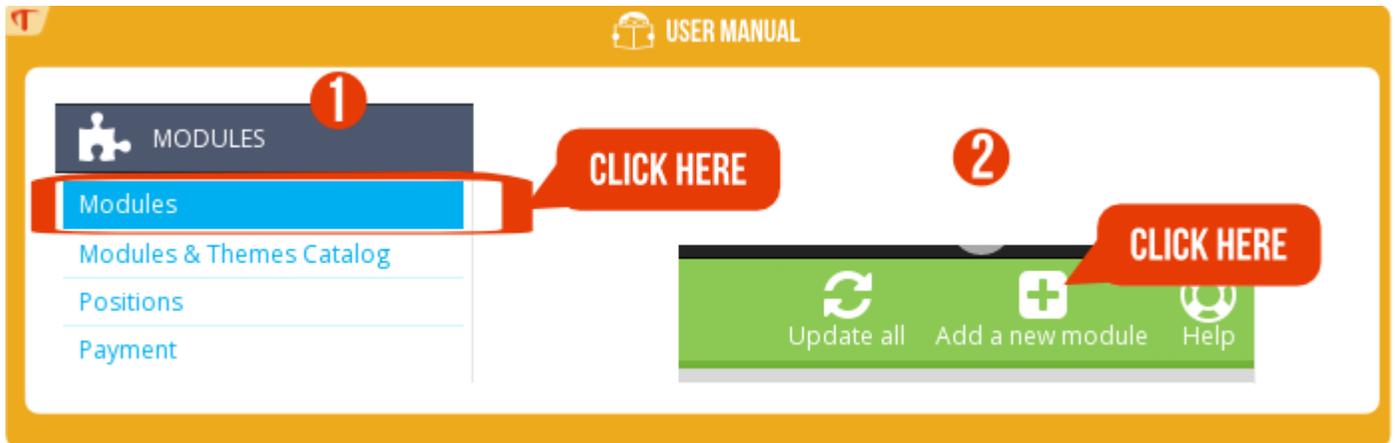
The presentation media images were taken from the 1.6.X version of PrestaShop.

1 SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

- Your version of Prestshop must be ≥ 1.5
- You have the Free Delivery Manager module

2 INSTALLATION

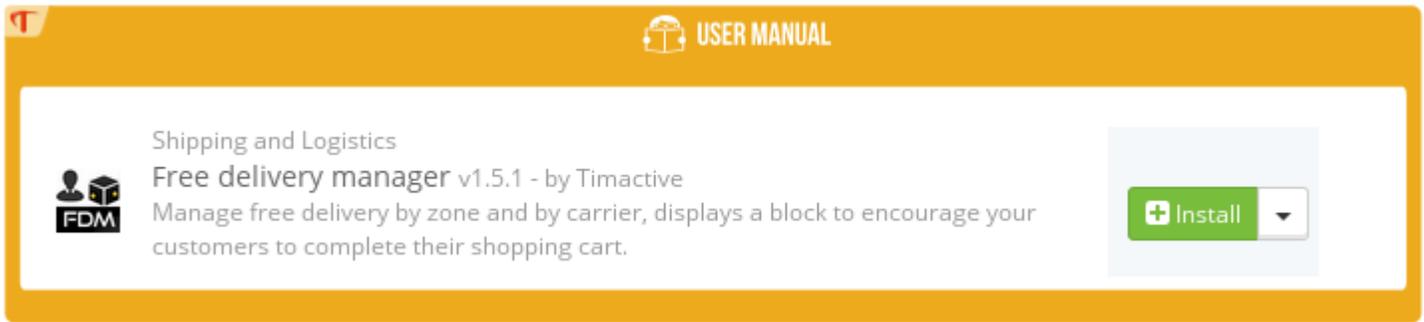
1. You have to go into the PrestaShop Back Office(administration) http://www.yourshop.com/admin***
2. Click on the **'Modules'** tab:



3. Choose « Add new module », click on the « choose a file » button

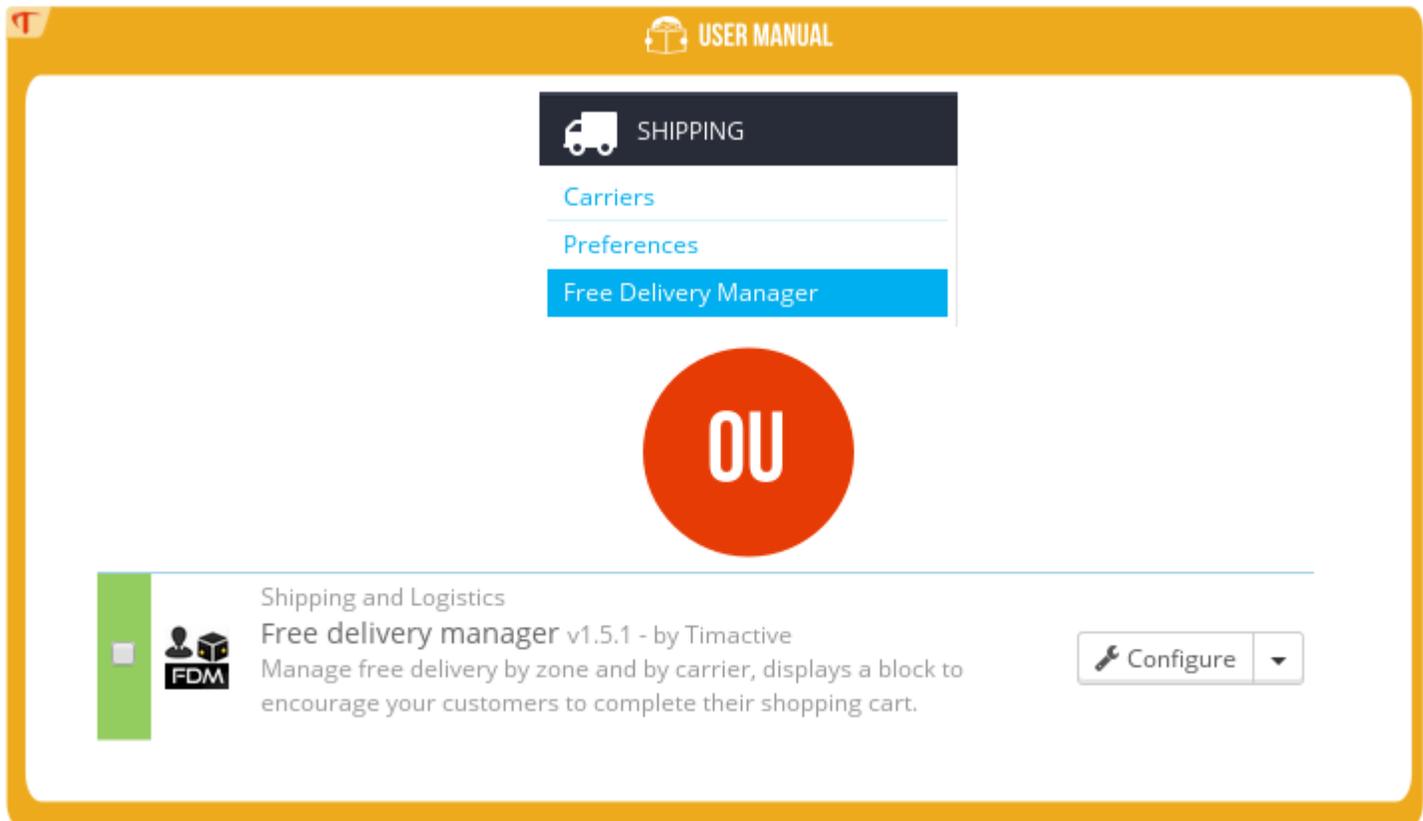
Once uploaded, the module will appear in the “Shipping and Logistics” tab



4. Click on the 'Install' button.

The module has now been successfully installed

3 ACCESS THE MODULE



There are two ways to access the module:

- (Quick) Shipping → Free delivery manager
- Modules → Free delivery manager → Click the “configure” button

4 CHECK INSTALLATION & CONFIGURATION

This step will validate that the module is installed and that your configuration of your store is OK for use of the module.

1 Your installation and preferences of your shop is OK, you can create your free delivery rules.

2 Click on the link “Click here” and set the field “Free shipping starts at” to 0

3 During installation of the module, PrestaShop applied this override
[your_shop]modules/freedeliverymanager/override/classes/Cart.php to [your_shop]override/classes/Cart.php.
This error is displayed when Prestashop could not apply this (right directory access, classes already overridden by another module, ...).

To solve the problem :

Edit the file [your_shop]/override/classes/Cart.php

And complete this with the file present in [your_shop]modules/freedeliverymanager/override/classes/Cart.php

This modification requires some technical skills, you can request our team to make this update, we will be happy to help you. FTP access to your store will be needed.

4 After installing the module, the cache file [your_shop]/cache/class_index.php must be initialized. If this installation was not realized by PrestaShop, just delete this file, it will be automatically recreated. (save the file before deleting)

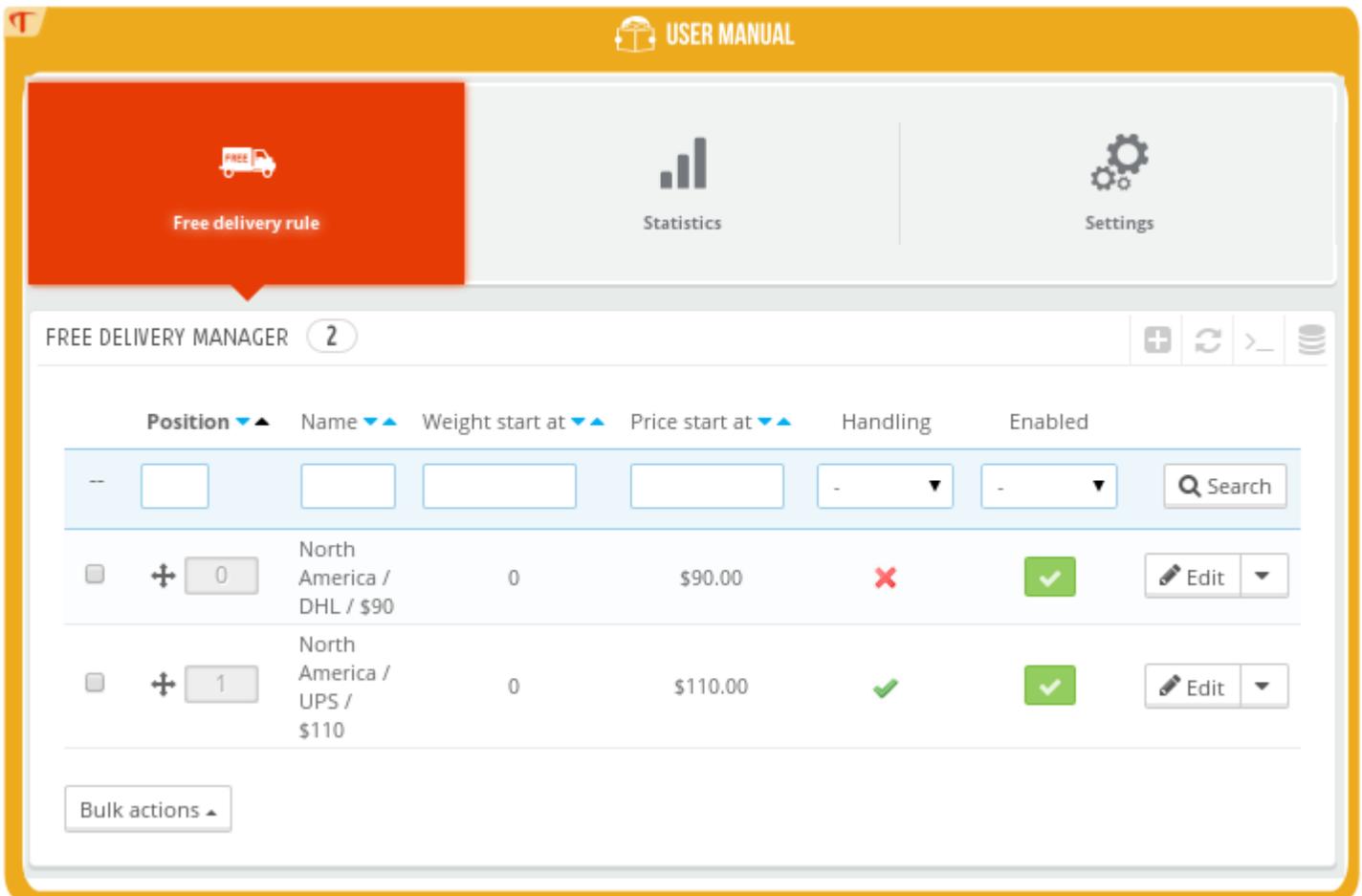
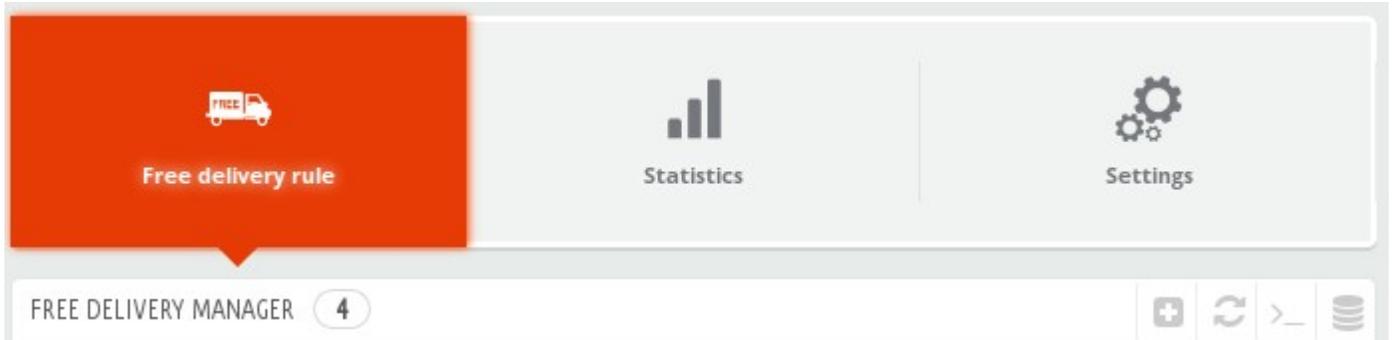

III USER GUIDE

1 FREE DELIVERY RULE

This section allows you to apply free delivery rules by several conditions (Zone, carrier, customer group, ...)



A CREATE A RULE

To create a rule click on the button "Create" button at the top right of the list

The rule will be applicable only if the total weight of the shopping cart is lower than this value. Condition is disabled, if this parameter is equal to 0.

Name:

For information purposes only, it should be unique in order to be easily found.

Free shipping starts at:(price)

Indicate the price from what the price will be offered

If you set parameters to 0, they will be disabled

Tax excluded :

No : Price is tax included

Yes : Price is tax excluded

Free shipping starts at:(weight)

Indicate the price from what the weight will be offered

If you set parameters to 0, they will be disabled

Maximum weight:

Specify a maximum weight, if the weight of the shopping cart is higher, the rule will not apply.

If this parameter is equal to 0, condition is disabled.

Handling charges :

Specifies whether, handling charges apply. If yes, they'll be added if you have specified this information to the carrier.

Additional shipping fees :

Specifies whether or not the additional shipping costs related to the products will be applicable.



* Additionnal shipping fees

If the rule is applied. Adds additional shipping fees of the products in the cart.

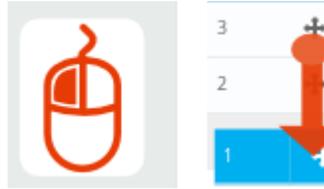


C PRIORITY



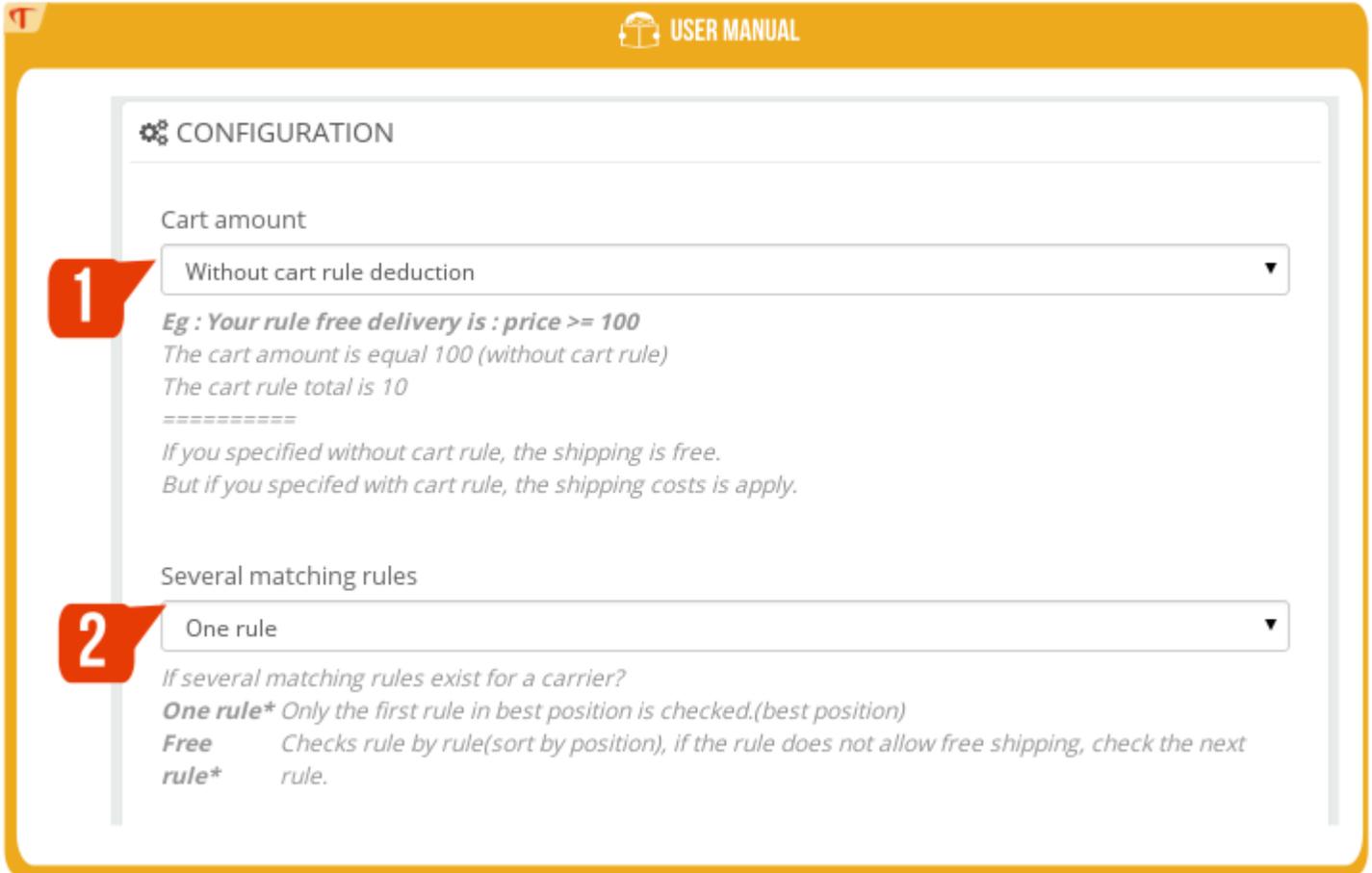
Change the priority of a rule by changing its position. The higher its position, the higher its priority.

“Drag and drop”: To change a position, left click and hold the icon, and move it up or down with your mouse.



2 SETTINGS

A MODULE BEHAVIOR

CART AMOUNT

Specify whether free delivery rules should refer to the amount of the cart without discount coupon or deducted coupon.

Eg : Your free delivery rule is : price >= \$100

The cart amount is equal to \$100 (without cart rule)

The cart rule amount is equal to \$10

If you specified without cart rule, the shipping is free.

But if you specified with cart rule, the shipping costs is apply.

SEVERAL MATCHING RULES

Two possible choices, "One rule" or "Free rule"

If several matching rules exists for a carrier?

One rule method: Only the first rule is applied.

Free rule : Checks rule by rule(sort by position), if the rule does not allow free shipping, the next rule is checked.

Example :

Your are defined 3 rules,

1 free delivery rule permit to offer **DHL** for customer in North America, price start at **\$90.00**.

2 free delivery rule permit to offer **UPS** for customer in North America, price start at **\$110.00**.

2 free delivery rule permit to offer **DHL, FEDEX** for customer in North America, price start at **\$50.00**.

Your customer want to be delivered by **DHL** in “New York”, the cart amount is equal to \$55.00.

2 rules matching for carrier **DHL & NORTH AMERICA**(RULE 1 & RULE 2)

You have selected “One rule” in configuration:

Only the rule 1 is checked, the shipping is not free because the cart amount is inferior at \$90.00

NEW YORK, DHL, CART=\$90.00

RULE 1 : DHL NORTH AMERICA, CART > \$90.00

RULE 2 : UPS, CART >\$110.00

RULE 3 : DHL & FEDEX NORTH AMERICA, CART >\$ 50

You have selected “free rule” in configuration :

Rule 1 is ignored does not allow obtaining freeshipping, Rule 3 is checked and allows the free shipping

NEW YORK, DHL, CART=\$90.00

RULE 1 : DHL NORTH AMERICA, CART > \$90.00

RULE 2 : UPS, CART >\$110.00

RULE 3 : DHL & FEDEX NORTH AMERICA, CART >\$ 50



3 FRONT OFFICE

This part concerns the block displayed at your "front office", in order summary.

A THE SELECTED COUNTRY FOR AN AUTHENTICATED CLIENT

For an authenticated client, the selected country will be the country corresponding to the delivery address. If it has not taken delivery address, the selected country will be deducted in the same way that a customer is not authenticated.

B CHANGE COUNTRY

If the selected country does not match the delivery location of your customer, The customer can change country directly with the dropdown.

C SENTENCE

More than \$18.00 purchase to enjoy free delivery
The amount of your purchases must exceed the minimum \$45.00

This sentence vocation to invite your users to complete their cart.

This sentence informs the customer on the minimum purchase amount remaining to enjoy the free shipping.

D FREE SHIPPING GRID

UNITED STATES GRID SHIPPING OFFERED BY CARRIER		
	DHL Delivery in 2 or 3 days	More than \$43.00
	Fedex Delivery in 2 or 3 days	More than \$18.00

This grid displays all the carriers with which your customer can enjoy free shipping, as defined in the rules. Here the country selected is United States.



E BLOCK & GRID DISPLAY CONFIGURATION

This section allows you to configure the block display or grid according to your preferences

1 BLOCK DISPLAY CONDITION :

Several options:

Every display : The block is always displayed(Although no rule is valid)

Never display : The block is never displayed

Not displayed if no free shipping in the country...: The block is displayed only if free delivery rules are present for the customer's country.

2 GRID DISPLAY CONDITION:

Never display : The grid is never displayed

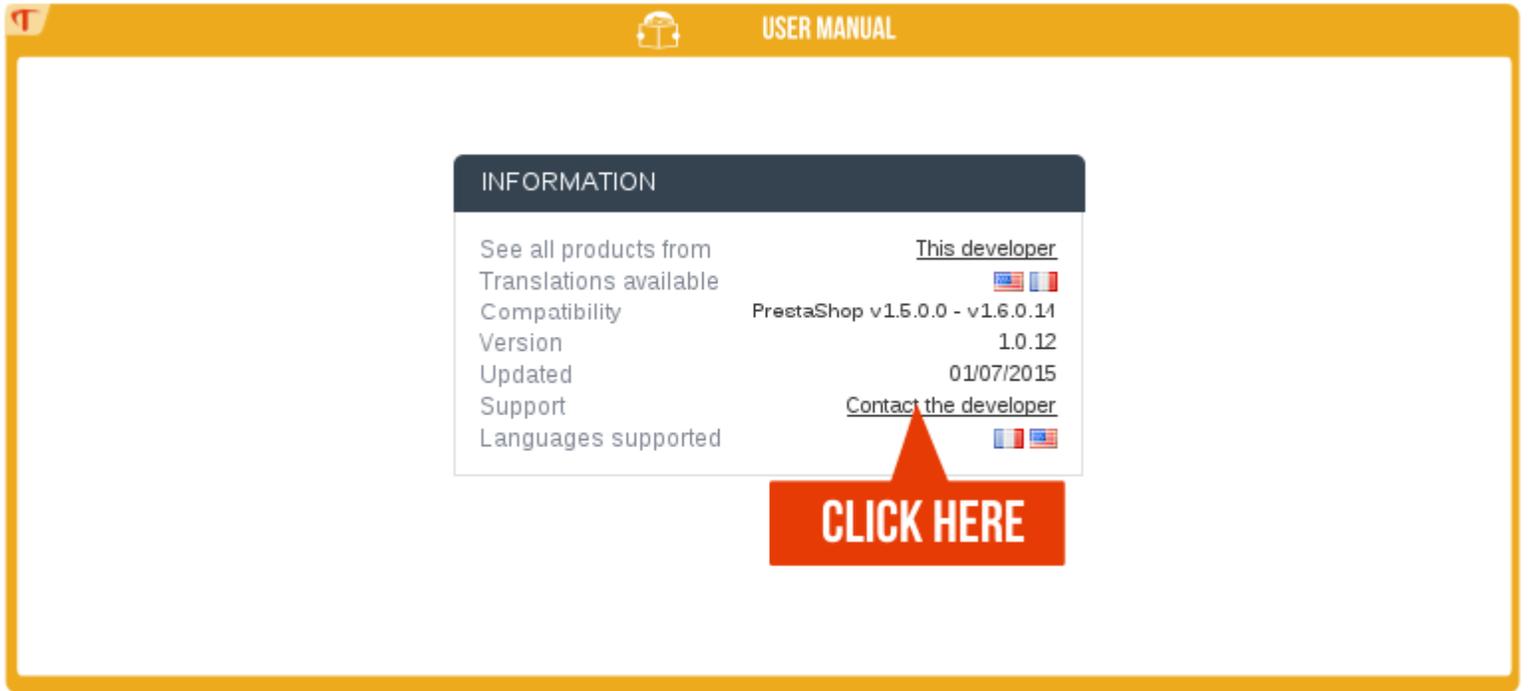
Number of line > 0: If the number of carrier is > 0, the grid will be displayed

Number of line > 1: If the number of carrier is > 1, the grid will be displayed
